Complete obstetric care includes prenatal care, delivery and postpartum visits. Developing a comfortable relationship with one provider does make it easier for you to ask questions and discuss problems. You may see other providers in our office during your pregnancy since delivery room coverage is on a rotating call basis.

Generally, you will be seen once a month until the seventh or eighth month and then you will be seen every two weeks. In the final month of pregnancy, you will be seen weekly. During your visits, please inform us if you are under the care of another physician or if medication has been prescribed. This information is necessary for us to provide the best possible care to both you and your baby.

Your office visits are much more than just an examination. We welcome your questions and we want you to be comfortable with both your pregnancy and the happy event of childbirth.

Gynecologic Care

We specialize in women's primary healthcare including annual exams, abnormal pap smear treatment, family planning, and diagnosis and treatment of infertility. Our providers also specialize in caring for the needs of menopausal women which include prevention and treatment of osteoporosis, hormone replacement therapy, surgical repair of urinary incontinence, and abnormal bleeding.

Our Fees

Our fees are determined by the individual care given and are competitive with area specialists. Health insurance may not cover the entire cost of your care. Copays are expected to be paid at the time of service. We encourage our patients to contact your insurance carrier to determine what is covered by your plan. Remember that your account is your responsibility even though you have insurance coverage.

Your Bill

We are very concerned about rising medical care costs and we make every effort to keep costs down. Payment at the time of services can help reduce these costs. Payment for non-covered services is expected at the time of service. We do accept cash, personal checks and credit cards. For your convenience, you may also pay your bill through our online bill pay service on our website.

We submit claims for all procedures, surgeries and obstetrical services. Statements are mailed monthly for any balance due on your account. Payment of your account balance is expected upon receipt of the bill. Patient due balances over 60 days are assessed an 18% annual finance fee. Again, if you have questions regarding your account or need to set up a financial arrangement, please request to meet with the Billing Specialist either during a visit or by scheduling an appointment.
